**Drawing Held:** 15 Oct. 2018

**Applicants Will Be Notified by Mail:** Post cards will be mailed 16 Oct. 2018

**Cost:** \$50.00 per hunter selected in the lottery. Permits can be purchased six working days prior to the mandatory meetings.

**Pre-Hunt Meetings:** The pre-hunt meeting is *mandatory* for at least one member of each team selected to hunt. Both members of the selected team may attend. See number 2 below for meeting dates and times.

- Drawing results will not be available by phone.**
- One hundred-twenty eight (128) applicants and 10 alternates will be randomly selected, by a drawing, to participate in the hunt. One-third of the hunters will be active duty; one-third of the hunters will be DoD affiliated and one-third of the hunters will be civilian.

- Hunters receiving postcards notifying selection for this year's hunt MUST call the Natural Resources Section at (850) 882-4165 or 4166 by COB on **26 October 18** to reserve their slot. Hunters who do not confirm their slots will forfeit their eligibility and their slot will be awarded to an alternate selected during the drawing.
- The hunt zones will be: Zone 1 (I-10 & I-28); Zone 2 (I-25); Zone 3 (I-27); Zone 4 (I-31 & I-32); Zone 5 (I-26); Zone 6 (I-24); Zone 7 (I-23) and Zone 8 (I-5 & I-6). The applicant(s) must stay within their assigned Tactical Training Areas (TTA's) when scouting and hunting.
- Hunters must check in/out at the Jackson Check Station during established reservation entry and exit times when scouting or hunting.
- The pre-hunt meeting will cover rules, hunting procedures, schedules, and field questions. If you choose to purchase your permit on the day of the pre-hunt meeting, please arrive at Jackson guard by 3:30 p.m. so the pre-hunt meeting can start promptly at 4:00 p.m.
- Legal game for the hunt includes white-tailed deer, feral hog, and coyote. Bag limit (per hunter) for white-tailed deer is 2 antlered or one antlered and one antlerless (spotted fawns may not be harvested). Legal antlered deer must have at least 3 points (1 inch in length) on one side or a main beam length of 10 inches or more to be legal to harvest. There is no size or bag limit on feral hogs and coyotes.
- Applicants will have to comply with all Eglin AFB hunting rules and regulations apply.
- Applicants will have to comply with all State of Florida hunting requirements including a valid Florida Hunting Permit.
- Applicants selected for a special hunt will need to provide a photo ID when purchasing their special hunt permit.
- Applicants claiming DoD Status will have to provide proof of DoD status when purchasing their special hunt permit.
- Applicants born after 1 Jun 1975 will need to provide proof of having completed an approved Hunter Education Course.
