**Mandatory Pre-Hunt Meeting:** 01 Feb 2019 at 4:00 P.M. at Jackson Guard

1. **Drawing results will not be available by phone.**
  2. Your name may only appear on one application. Multiple applications submitted by the mobility impaired hunt applicant will void their eligibility.
  3. Fifty (50) applicants and 10 alternates will be selected by a computer based weighted drawing system.
  4. Selected hunters may not transfer their application or permit to another individual.
  5. Mobility impaired hunters may be accompanied by one able-bodied, non-hunting “buddy” who must remain at the same stand site.
  6. Please be aware that the permit sales for this hunt will end 30 minutes prior to the 4:00 P.M. mandatory pre-hunt meeting.
  7. Portable or temporary blinds may be used or participants may hunt from their personally owned vehicle.
  8. Hunters must attend the mandatory pre-hunt meeting. Stand sites will be drawn; rules, procedures, and schedules will be addressed during the meeting.
  9. Legal game will include white-tailed deer, feral hog and coyotes. Weekend bag limit for white-tailed deer is 2 antlered or one antlered and one antlerless (except a spotted fawn). All legal antlered deer harvested on the Eglin reservation must have at least 3 points (1 inch or more in length) on one side OR have a main beam length of 10 inches or more to be legal to harvest. There is no size or bag limit for wild hog and coyotes.
  10. All weapons legal for deer hunting within the State of Florida are permitted.
  11. Primitive camping is permitted at a nearby campground at a cost of **\$5 PER NIGHT**
  12. The State of Florida and Eglin AFB hunting rules and regulations apply.
