Spring Hog Dog Hunt FY24 Eglin AFB Special Opportunity Hunt



Permits available beginning: 01 Feb. 2024 Permit Cost: \$25.00

- 1. The Public Access Map (PAM) must be checked prior to entering the Eglin reservation and **all permanent and daily closures must be adhered to**.
- 2. The Eglin Spring Hog Dog Hunt is a special opportunity hunt for those individuals that **hunt hogs with the aid of dogs**. Catch and trail dogs are permitted. **Each dog must be equipped and monitored with devices that allow remote tracking and behavior control**. Dogs being transported (i.e., not actively chasing/hunting) are exempt from this requirement.
- 3. <u>Firearm use/possession is restricted to ONE rimfire pistol per hunting party</u> for the purpose of dispatching bayed or caught hogs. <u>Hunting hogs with rimfire pistols independent of the use of dogs is prohibited during this hunt.</u>
- 4. All participants and companions > 15 YOA are required to purchase a Spring Hog Dog Hunt Permit <u>and keep a signed copy</u> <u>of these regulations in their possession while on the Eglin reservation</u>.
- 5. Hunting will be permitted from 4:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. on the designated hunting days.
- 6. Hunting will be **permitted in all <u>open areas</u> between RR236 and State Hwy 331 (except the Brier Creek MUs are <u>CLOSED</u> to this hunt). Management Unit motorized vehicle restrictions (no vehicle and walk-in areas) that apply during the regular hunting seasons apply to the Eglin AFB Spring Hog Dog Hunt.**
- 7. There is no check-in/out requirement for this hunt, regardless of the Management Unit being hunted.
- 8. Only wild hogs may be taken during this special hunt. There is no size or bag limit for hog harvest. <u>All hogs caught must be</u> <u>immediately dispatched</u>. The release of any captured hog is prohibited, as is the transportation of live hogs.
- 9. Allowing dogs to pursue any species other than hogs (e.g. deer, coyote, fox, etc.) is prohibited.
- 10. The Spring Hog Dog Hunt Permit allows entry to the Eglin reservation on the dates specified on the permit only.

- 12. Your signature acknowledges that you have read and understand these regulations and agree to comply with all Eglin regulations and guidelines, and will provide a Harvest Record (see back) to the NRO by the Wednesday following your hunt.

REMINDER

Hogs carry a number of diseases of which hunters and consumers of hog meat should be aware. Visit *eglin.iSportsman.net* and click on the "Hunting" tab to access brochures outlining risks and preventative measures when hunting and processing wild hogs.

<u>All individual hunters or hunting parties (even if unsuccessful) are required to complete the Harvest Record</u> on the back of these guidelines and return to the Natural Resources Office (NRO) by COB on the Wednesday following the hunt. <u>Failure to turn in a Harvest Record may result in your hog hunting privilege being suspended next year</u>. If you did not harvest a hog, indicate a zero on those days you were unsuccessful. If you did not hunt all days, please indicate that on the harvest record as well. <u>One individual hunter may turn in a Harvest Record on behalf of a hunting party/group, but must clearly note the other hunting party members on the Harvest Record</u>.
