Hunt Dates:

Eligibility	- Applicants must meet the FWC <u>Mobility Impaired Certification</u> requirement and have a state mobility impaired certification. Applications submitted by individuals with past or current NOVAAs will be reviewed for eligibility.
Applicants	- Applicants may be accompanied by one able-bodied, <u>non-hunting</u> assistant who must remain with the applicant at the stand site during the hunt. Any applicant whose name appears on multiple applications will be removed from the lottery.
Application Period 1 Sept. - 31 Dec. 2026 <u>DO NOT</u> e-mail or fax	Application must be mailed or returned in person to the Natural Resources Office within the Application Period. The NRO is not responsible for applications lost in the mail. - The NRO will not accept mailed applications arriving after the due date. - Incomplete or illegible applications will not be entered in the lottery.
Drawing 07 Jan. 2027	- A random drawing will select 50 applications to participate in the 2-day hunt. - Alternates will be drawn as replacements if a selected hunter cannot hunt.
Drawing Notification 08 Jan. 2027	- View lottery results on eglin.isportsman.net under the Special Opportunity Hunts/Events heading, select the Mobility Impaired Hunt from the drop-down menu. Hunters selected will be identified by the following information provided from their application: 1) First initial of first and last name 2) Mobility Impaired Certification Number 3) Last three digits of phone number Example: BM / 123456 / 145 Drawing results WILL NOT be available over the phone.
Confirm Acceptance by 15 Jan 2027	Applicants selected but not confirming their slot by COB on the established date will forfeit their slot to the first available alternate.
Cost of Hunt \$25.00 per hunter	- Selected applicants can purchase their Sp. Opp. Hunt Permit the week prior to the hunt. - Applicants must provide a photo ID and Mobility Impaired Certificate at time of permit purchase. - Selling or transferring permits is prohibited. A \$5 FWC deer permit is required for all applicable hunters. Non-resident hunters will need to purchase (at minimum) a \$46.50 Florida 10-day non-resident hunting permit as well (not sold at Jackson Guard).
Pre-Hunt Meeting 12 Feb. 2027	- Pre-hunt meeting will be at Jackson Guard @ 4:00 p.m. CST. Please arrive 30 minutes early to allow time to purchase permit. <u>MANDATORY for every selected applicant.</u> Non-hunting assistant encouraged to also attend. - Meeting will cover the special opportunity hunt rules, procedures, schedules, and answer any questions. - All hunting rules and regulations for the State of Florida and Eglin AFB apply to this hunt.
Legal to Take	- Antlered deer must have 3 points (≥ 1 inch in length) on a side or a main beam length of 10 inches or greater. - Antlerless deer without antlers or antlers less than 5 inches in length (<u>NO spotted fawns</u>). - Wild Hog and Coyote
Bag Limits (per hunter)	2 antlered deer or 1 antlered and 1 antlerless. Harvested deer count toward the FWC's 5 deer statewide annual limit per hunter. FWC's deer harvest reporting requirements must be followed. - No limit on wild hog or coyote.
Hunt Locations	- A Jackson Guard escort is required when travelling to and from your hunt location. - Hunters must stay at their assigned hunt location; safety protocol prohibits moving around without your guide.
Check Station Requirement	- All harvested game must be checked at the Check Station. - All hunters must check out with their Jackson Guard escort when leaving for the day.
